CASE OF ABANDON OF AN ATHLETE

An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give up by decision of the race director or the doctor.

Every athlete having withdrawn **MUST** inform the President of Jury (or a representative of him/her) upon arrival at the finish area, and especially the Anti-Doping Delegate.

The athletes having withdrawn may also be subjected to doping control.

In case of abandon, the athlete who does not inform the organisation will start in the rear part in the following competition.

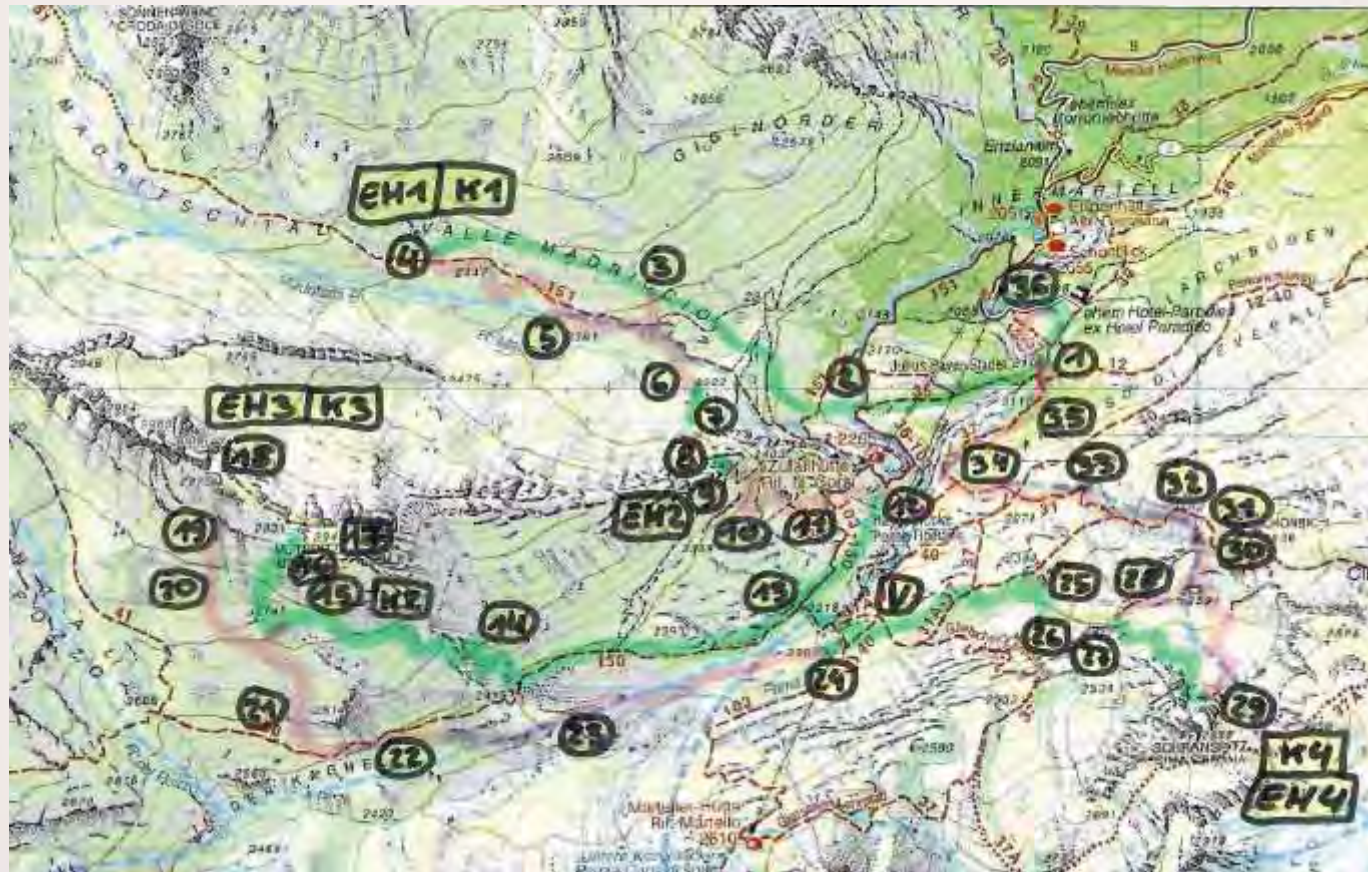

Safety along the route is guaranteed by 4 First-Aid Stations, 2 Avalanche Rescue Dogs and 70 Track Attendants of Mountain Rescue, all equipped with Radio!

CAR PASS – SHUTTLE SERVICE

- Due to limited parking space, only a specified number of cars are allowed to park near the individual start
- Approximately 35 parking lots are reserved for teams
- Teams will get a „**Green Car Pass**“ to park at reserved parking space
- Each team will get at least 1 „Green Car Pass“. For every 8 athletes the teams get 1 additional „Green Car Pass“
