






Race Location






3rd DOWNHILL (FROM SUMMIT)



Case of abandon of an athlete

An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give up by decision of the race director or the doctor.

Every athlete having withdrawn MUST inform the President of the Technical Jury (or a representative of him/her) upon arrival at the finish area, and especially the Anti-Doping Delegate.

The athletes having withdrawn may also be subjected to doping control.

In case of abandon, the athlete who does not inform the organisation will start in the rear part in the following competition.


